The Church

What is the church: <u>The Church is the sacramental Body of Christ, a baptismal community that is described as a</u> <u>priesthood, a royal nation, God's own possession, a pillar of truth.</u>

- **1 Corinthians 10:16-17**: Not literal or metaphorical but "Sacramentally" His Body in the Eucharist: offering our life
- **1 Corinthians 12:13,27**: Baptism = reborn as members of the body of Christ + each other: baptism = shared life
- **1 Peter 2:9** w/ Galatians 6:2; we are a priesthood bear burdens to the Lord and bear the Lord to the burdens

How has the church been described through the Christian tradition: <u>The Church has been and is described as one, holy,</u> <u>catholic, and apostolic church.</u>

- One Holy: See above: one body under Christ + Holy: set apart to touch and be touched- character matters!
- Catholic: We proclaim the whole faith to all people until the end of time: Matthew 28:18-20
- Apostolic: We are built on the foundation of the apostles and continue in their teaching: Eph 2:20 + Acts 2:42

What is the mission of the church and how does the church carry out this mission: <u>The mission of the church is to</u> continue the restorative work of The Father and the Son, through the Spirit, in prayer, worship, proclamation of the Gospel, promotion of justice, peace and love.

- **1 Tim 3:15**; the church holds up the person of Jesus Christ as the truth Himself to be inhabited
- John 20:19-23; the church brings the full essence of the cross to bear on the lives of others
- **Ephesians 3:7-10**; the church brings Christ's justice to bear on the world and the systems therein

Through whom does the church carry out its mission: <u>*The church carries out her mission through the ministry of the saints, the Eucharistic community empowered by the Spirit.*</u>

- John 21:15-18; forgiveness + loving Christ leads to responsibility / forgiveness stabilizes us / Love sends us forth
- **2 Corinthians 5:20**; Jesus/God shares his redemptive life with us and through us: redemption is sharing His life
- **Ephesians 4:11-14**; No one is qualified to minister who is not called to be ministered to regularly
